

## **Yellow Fever**

### **Health Requirements**

A person seeking to enter the Republic of South Africa may be required to produce an international health certificate containing details of vaccination.

Immunization for yellow fever is a requirement if the journey starts or entails passing through the yellow fever belt of Africa or South America. The following countries fall within the belt:

**Africa: Angola; Burundi; Benin; Burkina Faso; Cameroon; Central Africa Republic; Chad; Congo; Democratic Republic of Congo; Equatorial Guinea; Ethiopia; Gambia; Gabon; Ghana; Guinea; Guinea-Bissau; Ivory Coast; Kenya; Liberia; Mali; Niger; Nigeria; Rwanda; Sao Tome & Principe; Senegal; Sierra Leone; Somalia; Sudan; Tanzania; Togo; Uganda**

**South America: Bolivia; Brazil; Colombia; Ecuador; French Guyana; Guyana; Panama; Peru; Suriname; Venezuela**

Yellow fever certificates are valid for a period of 10 years commencing 10 days after the date of immunization or, in the case of re-immunization, within such a period of 10 years, from the date of that re-immunization.
